**ORDER SEALING STATE'S EXPEDITED MOTION REGARDING  
CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED MATTERS**

**THIS MATTER** having come before the Court on the State's February 7, 2024, Motion to Seal Expedited Motion Regarding Confidential and Privileged Matters, the Court having granted the motion finds as follows:

**THE COURT ENTERS THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:**

1. The State's motion concerns matters to which the defendant has a compelling right to privacy and a statutory right to confidentiality. The defendant's rights in this matter are an overriding interest that overcomes the right of public access to the court record.
2. The defendant's overriding interest supports sealing the court record.
3. A substantial probability exists that the overriding interest will be prejudiced if the court record is not sealed.
4. The proposed sealing is narrowly tailored and no less restrictive means exist to achieve the overriding interest.

**IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:**

1. The entirety of the State's Expedited Motion Regarding Confidential and Privileged Matters shall be SEALED until further order of the Court.
2. All responsive pleadings and any hearing on the matter shall also be sealed until further order of the Court.
3. The sealed motion and any responsive pleadings shall only be accessible by the following parties: Kari T. Morrissey, Jason, J. Lewis, Jason Bowles, Todd Bullion and Hannah Gutierrez. The parties granted access are prohibited from sharing the motion with any other person or entity until further of the Court.
