**STIPULATED PROTECTIVE ORDER ON THE FORENSIC DOWNLOAD OF
DEFENDANT'S CELLUAR PHONE**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon the stipulation of the parties who hereby agree that good cause exists and justice requires a protective order prohibiting the public release of the contents of Defendant's cellular phone and the corresponding forensic download of Defendant's cellular phone, and the Court being fully advised of the premises,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in accordance with NMRA Rule 5-501(F)(2) and 5-507(A) there is a substantial risk to Defendant of physical harm, intimidation, unnecessary annoyance of embarrassment that will result from the public disclosure of the content of Defendant's cellular phone contained within the forensic download that was conducted in the course of the investigation, and that good cause exists and justice

requires a protective order prohibiting the public release of the contents contained within the Defendant's cellular phone retrieved via the forensic download of her cellular device.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this protective order does not supersede or overrule the Court's previous ruling regarding the admissibility of potentially relevant portions of Defendant's cellular phone at jury trial.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the protective order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
