ORDER DENYING BALDWIN'S MOTION TO COMPEL

The Notice of Completion of Briefing Baldwin's Motion to Compel was filed on July 7, 2024. The parties argued the matter before the Court on July 8, 2024. At oral argument, the Court ordered the parties to meet and confer to determine whether the parties could agree on a satisfactory resolution to the motion.

After the meet and confer, Baldwin represented he is satisfied with Ms. Johnson's representation that she had engaged in a good-faith review of the discovery at issue in the motion to compel. Ms. Johnson agreed to review certain redacted documents identified by Baldwin, and Baldwin has accepted Ms. Johnson's explanation of the remaining redactions. The State further provided a more detailed witness order and agreed to continue to update the defense with any expected changes to the witness order. Baldwin is satisfied that this combination has sufficiently addressed the outstanding concerns and agreed to withdraw the Motion to Compel

Accordingly, on consent of the parties, Baldwin's Motion to Compel is hereby DENIED.
