Question (1)

Appendix B: Letter of Transmittal: To what does “acknowledgement” and “acceptance” on the transmittal letter refer?

Answer:

RFP Page 11: “Offerors must indicate their acceptance of the Conditions Governing the Procurement section in the letter of transmittal.”

RFP Page 16: Letter of Transmittal must “acknowledge receipt of any and all amendments to this RFP.”

Question (2)

May this submission be digital format?

Answer:

Page 15 of the RFP outlines the proposal format. The submission must be in PDF format and a digital file.

Question (3)

If digital, may a thumb drive, for example, be dropped off by the due date to the court?

Answer:

Page 15 states that if the PDF is too large to be emailed, it can be uploaded. Uploads can be sent as a Google Drive to the court email contacts instead of an email attachment. A thumb drive of the PDF files, timely dropped off at the courthouse, is another acceptable method to submit. If you drop off a thumb drive, please email a notification of where and with whom you dropped off the drive to Procurement Manager Dasha Bazhura.

Question (4)

Is it possible to inquire how many formal intentions to pursue the RFP were received by the court?

Answer:

Two (2) acknowledgements of receipt have been received by the Court in response to RFP 2026-02. The contents of the submissions are confidential. NMSA 1978, § 13-1-116 (2026) (“The contents of any proposal shall not be disclosed so as to be available to competing offerors during the negotiation process.”).
